Advenio eAcademy was the first educational institution in Malta providing on-line certified courses licensed by the Malta further and Higher Education Authority in Malta, MFHEA. The programme is built around the interactive functionality of its e-learning platform that includes access to resource libraries, audio-visual and video presentations, forum and wiki capabilities. It integrates self-learning and collaborative learning activities. Key Benefits of the Programme

The top-up programme is designed and developed by Advenio eAcademy and the University of Ioannina. It is based on the established Bachelor's Degree in Nursing offered by the Department of Nursing at the University of Ioannina in Greece. This is a programme for qualified and experienced nurses that want to build a career in nursing in Europe. Students that successfully complete the programme may apply for inclusion on the Malta Register of Nurses which enable them to work in Malta or any other EU country.

Bachelor's Degree in Nursing (Top-Up)

This top-up degree programme in Nursing builds on the knowledge and know-how acquired by students through previous studies and work experience. (Minimum prerequisites: - 120 ECTS credits at Level 5 & one year's work experience minimum of 2,300 hours). This integrative programme develops the student's knowledge and understanding of multidisciplinary work in health and social care environments within a European context. It is based on active participation of students to expand their skill sets and knowledge, ensuring they become effective, up-to-date and context-relevant practitioners able to contribute directly within EU-regulated healthcare institutions.

The course is designed to provide an overall understanding and insight into individualised care and person-centred care for individual patients, informal careers and family members by developing their critical decision-making and thinking skills based on the best available evidence, reflective knowledge based on specific individuals and cases, and qualitative and quantitative research finding. It includes training in quantitative and qualitative research methods and reflective tools and techniques for systematic analysis of practice and literature, thereby enabling the analysis, justification, and development of students' knowledge base and practice skills. Participants will also be introduced to decision-making and problem-solving tools, and the evaluation of processes and services, including reflective, evidence-based, and value-based models of care. Finally, students will engage with concepts and frameworks concerning ethical decision-making and professional practice. Thus, students will be given the opportunity to learn from practice and put into practice what they have learned, hence honing their employability skills.



Part-time Online Learning Programmes

This part-time online option meets the requirements of international students that are not in a position to travel to further their studies. It is ideal for practicing nurses that need the top-up qualifications to enable them to travel to Europe to further their career.

Full-time Blended Learning Programmes in Malta

The more intensive blended learning programme takes place in Malta. This involves implementation of subject course modules in parallel with the final research project. Additional on-site support classes are provided to allow for programme implementation in the reduced timeframe of 40 weeks.

Advenio eAcademy has a strategic collaboration with the reputed Easy School of Languages in Valletta and shares the ESL Training Centre in Valletta for the delivery of on-site support classes for the blendedlearnning programmes in Malta. These premises combine the charm of a historic palazzo with the convenience and facilities expected in a modern educational institution.

An optional online course module titled "Maltese for the healthcare sector" will be available to those students that plan to apply for work in the Maltese healthcare sector. This optional online course will provide students with the basic grammar of the Maltese Language as well as providing useful vocabulary they are likely to encounter in their role as nurses.
